ICU NURSE RESIDENCY

The Intensive Care Unit (ICU) Nurse Residency program is accredited by the ANCC Practice Transition Accreditation Program.



It is an opportunity for new RNs who are interested in a career in critical care. The residency consists of six monthly classes, comprised of both didactic education and simulation scenarios (nine total), as well as an approximately six month clinical orientation, under the guidance of a skilled preceptor.

Through this program, residents will learn how to function in the role of the critical care nurse and will develop the skills, knowledge and confidence to succeed.

Residents will receive comprehensive training in intensive care skills and learn critical thinking skills to identify, plan and provide individualized patient care.
