

EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT NURSE RESIDENCY

The Emergency Department Nurse Residency program is an opportunity for new graduate RNs who are interested in a career in the Emergency Department.



The residency begins with didactic education in the classroom and simulation labs, followed by a six month clinical orientation and monthly didactic classroom and simulation education. To provide a multidisciplinary approach, Clinical Education Specialists, Community Experts and Critical Care Specialties provide education on the complex role of an Emergency Department nurse.

Through this program, participants will learn how to function in the Emergency Department nurse role and how to care for critical patients that arrive to the Emergency Department through exposure to cardiac arrest, precipitous delivery, trauma, critical care and many other topics specific to Emergency Medicine.

Throughout the residency program, nurses are provided with opportunities to interact with various departments, including ICU, Labor & Delivery and a local EMS ride along.
