

Considering a Career in Nutrition/Dietetics?

Once you've attained your High School Diploma or GED, you can pursue:

- Nutrition Assistant
- Room Service Ambassador
- Call Center Clerk
- Nutrition and Dietetics Technician, Registered (NDTR): Associate Degree (2 years)
- Registered Dietitian Nutritionist (RDN): Baccalaureate Degree (4 years); Master's Degree will be required beginning Jan 1, 2024

Once you've attained your Associate Degree, you can pursue:

- Nutrition Supervisor

Once you've attained your Registered Dietitian Nutritionist, you can pursue:

- Board Certification as a Specialist in Pediatric, Renal, Gerontological, Pediatric Critical Care, Oncology, as well as Sports Dietetics and Obesity and Weight Management.
- Certified Nutrition Support Clinician (recommended 2 years practice in Nutrition Support prior to exam)

Once you've attained your Master's Degree, you can pursue:

- Doctorate Degree (examples may include Doctorate of Philosophy PhD, Doctorate in Clinical Nutrition DCN, Doctorate in Nutrition and Dietetics DND)
