Occupational Therapy*:

- Occupational Therapist: Baccalaureate Degree (3-4 years) followed by required post graduate Master or Doctor of Occupational Therapy (2-3 years)
- Occupational Therapy (OT) Assistant: Associate of Science degree 2 years
 - Once you become an OT Assistant, you can pursue:
 - Bridge program to occupational therapist degree:
 - Bachelor of Science (1-2 years) followed by postgraduate:
 - Master of Occupational Therapy (2-3 years) or
 - Doctor of Occupational Therapy (2-3 years)

Physical Therapy*:

- Physical Therapist: Baccalaureate Degree (3-4 years) followed by required post graduate Doctor of Physical Therapy (3 years)
- Physical Therapy (PT) Assistant: Associate of Science degree 2 years
 - Once you become a PT Assistant, you can pursue:
 - Bridge program to physical therapist degree:
 - Bachelor of Science (1-2 years) followed by postgraduate:
 - Doctor of Physical Therapy (2-3 years)

Speech Therapy*:

• Speech Language Pathologist: Baccalaureate Degree (3-4 years) followed by required post graduate Speech Language Pathologist (2 years)

^{*}Each degree requires successful passing of a national board exam upon completion of the college curriculum.
