We invite **full-time** NKU students to apply for a scholarship up to **\$10,000** funded by St. Elizabeth Healthcare.

#### Scholarship Eligibility and Important Information:

- Must be accepted for admission as a degree seeking student at NKU.
- Must be a College of Health and Human Services student studying Radiologic Science, Radiation Therapy, or Respiratory Care -OR- a student in the accelerated or traditional Bachelor of Science in Nursing program.
- Scholarships will be awarded based on merit.
- NKU will give scholarship preference to seniors; high achieving juniors may also be considered.
- Eligible students must agree, if offered and accepted, to maintain employment with St. Elizabeth Healthcare for up to a period of 4,160 hours worked beginning within three months of the student's graduation date.
- Scholarship amount:
  - Up to **\$10,000** with 4,160 hours work commitment.
  - Up to **\$5,000** with 2,080-hours work commitment.

The scholarship recipient will be chosen in accordance with university policies and procedures. The Scholarship distribution will be administered by the Office of Financial Aid in conjunction with the College of Health and Human Services.
